

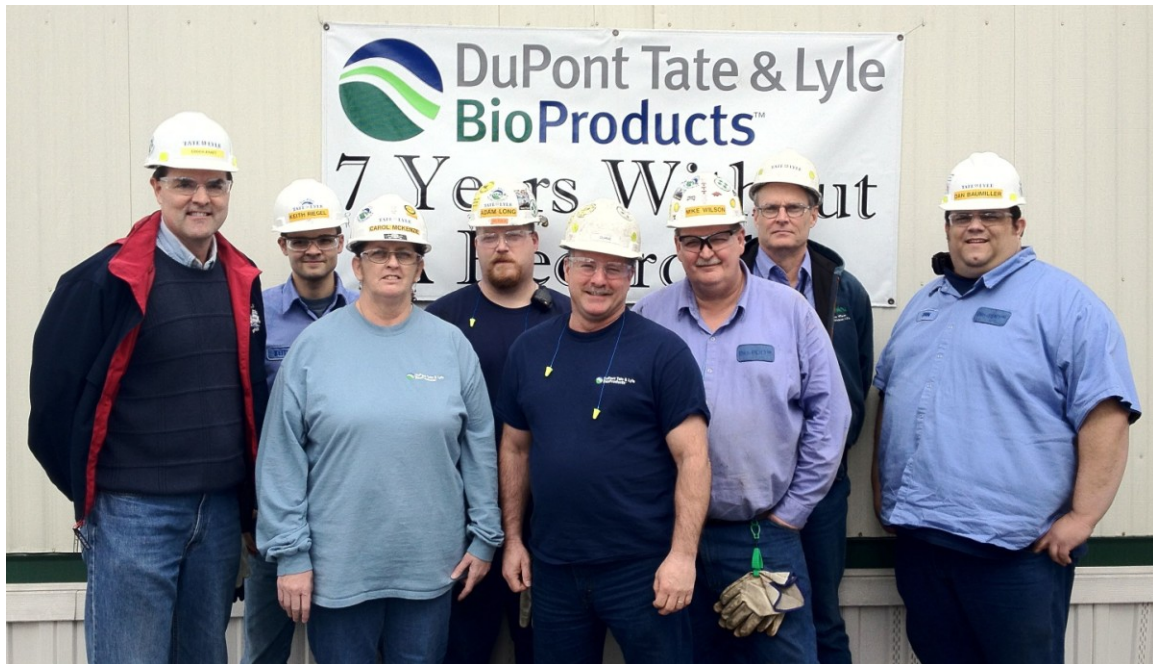
DuPont Tate & Lyle BioProducts™ wins safety award

Embracing DuPont's safety core value, DuPont Tate & Lyle BioProducts received Tate & Lyle's "Flagship Safety Award" for its superior safety record – more than 2,750 days without a recordable incident. The Bio-PDO™ business has operated without a recordable incident since the joint venture was formed July 1, 2004.

The [DuPont Tate & Lyle BioProducts](#) plant, located in Loudon, Tennessee, received the award in the small plant category, competing against other Tate & Lyle sites with fewer than 100 employees. The award recognizes safety excellence of sites in the United States, Mexico, South America and Asia.

Vice President of Operations Chuck Kraft attributed the success of the Bio-PDO safety program to employees' feeling of empowerment to safety and a genuine concern for their fellow employees. He also noted that the safety program exemplifies the plant's "Show Me You Care – Make Me Aware" culture.
